From NEC main entrance, take a right into the coastal exhibit by the escalator & look right to see me munching on a tasty snack!


What is one thing you can do today to help loggerhead sea turtles in North Carolina?

air!

Red-cockaded Woodpecker

Where I am in the museum:

Head up to the 2nd floor. Head toward the tall longleaf pine trees of the Savannas. Look up high to find a bird peeking out of its nest surrounded by tree sap, that's where you'll find me!
